With reference to your request on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Competent Authority vide U.O.No 1959/DE dated 28.02.2019 for grant of **Introduction/recognition (provisionally) of primary section (pre-school to Class-V) only for two years from academic session 2019-20 to 2020-21 (upto 31.03.2021) in respect of Geeta Bal Bharti Sr. Sec. 4. The school shall comply with the provisions of Rules 176,177, 18(5), 17(3) & order dated 15.12.99, 10.02.2005, 11.02.2009, 16.04.2010 & 19.02.2016 dealing with the regulation of fee alongwith the subsequent orders issued by DoE from time to time.
5. The school shall comply with the order dated 07.11.2017/guidelines of DoE and judicial pronouncements w.r.t. safety & security of the school children and take all steps in this regard.
6. Compliance of other conditions as mentioned in recognition/provisional recognition/up-gradation/provisional up-gradation granted to the school.

उपरोक्त विषय पर प्राप्त आपके पत्र संख्या शून्य दिनांक 4.12.79 के संदर्भ में आपको सूचित किया जाता है कि शिक्षा निर्देशक महोदय ने आपके विद्यालय को कक्षा छठी से आठवीं §6-8 § तक नये पत्र 19780-1981 से अनुदान रहित निम्नलिखित शर्तों पर मान्यता करना स्वीकार किया है ।

1. विद्यालय दिल्ली शिक्षा अधिनियम 1973 का पूर्ण पालन करेगा ।
2. अध्यापकों को दिल्ली के सरकारी विद्यालयों के अध्यापकों कर्मचारियों के समान वेतनमान तथा अन्य भत्ते व लाभ दिया जायेगा ।
3. विद्यालय को पांच हजार रुपये जर्व करके तीन महीने के अन्दर एक प्रयोगशाला स्थापित करनी होगी ।
4. विद्यालय को पुस्तकालय के लिए तीन महीने के अन्दर कम से कम एक हजार रुपये मूल्य की पुस्तकें खरीदनी होगी ।
5. विद्यालय के लिए अलकूद के समुचित व्यवस्था करनी होगी ।
6. नर्सरी कक्षाये विद्यालय के प्रांगण से बाहर चलाया जायेगा ।
7. विद्यालय स्कीम आफ मैनेजेंट तथा टीचर्स एग्जामिनेट की प्रतियां तीन महीने के अन्दर विभाग को उपलब्ध करायेगा और इन पर अनुमोदन लेगा ।
8. विद्यालय के विभाग द्वारा स्वीकृत पाठ्य-पुस्तकें लगायी जाये और जो भी अध्यापक भर्ती किए जाएंगे, उनकी योग्यता सरकारी विद्यालयों के अध्यापकों की योग्यताएँ समक्ष होगी ।
9. निर्धारित फीस बिना अनुमति के नहीं बढ़ाई जाये ।
10. शिक्षा निर्देशक तथा विद्यालय के प्रबन्धक के संयुक्त नाम में किसी राष्ट्रीय कृत बैंक में पांच हजार रुपये की राशि सावाधिक जाले में तीन महीने के भीतर जमा करा दी जाए ।
11. विद्यालय स्थल का प्रयोग किसी व्यापारिक कार्य निवास हेतु न किया जाए तथा विद्यालय में बिना किसी जाति धारण तथा सामुदायिक के मत-भेद के सभी को प्रवेश दिया जाये ।

Subject:- Upgradation of school from Middle to Secondary level
without Aid from Academic Session 1984-85.

Sir,

With reference to your Application on the subject cited above, approval for the upgradation of the existing Middle School to Secondary level is granted with effect from 1984-85 Session subject to the fulfillment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provision of Delhi School Education Act & Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the school shall appoint full-time qualified and eligible staff for all the classes of the school, as per the present Norms of the Department. Additional staff shall be provided for Secondary classes immediately.
4. That the school shall equip the science Labs, as per the Norms of the Department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading-room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student shall be provided.
6. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Sec.10(1) of the Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973.
8. That the enrolment in section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq. ft. per student for the available floor area of the class room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation, as per the Norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing class-rooms of proper size in the school.

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9. That the school shall not run any unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the above address only.
10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and overaged staff, if any, immediately.
11. That the scheme of management shall be got approved from the Department immediately.
12. That the service contract between the Management and the staff shall be executed immediately.
13. That all facilities prescribed under the Rules 50 and 51 of the D.S.E.R. 1973 shall be made available to the students and Rules 6, 7, 8 and 9 may be observed strictly.
14. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to the students as well as the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the Local Body within a month.
15. That the Management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs.15,000/- (Rs. Fifteen Thousand) only.
16. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the Department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school. Conditions imposed earlier may also be fulfilled.
17. That the Management of the School shall not appoint any new teachers and will not give any promotion to the teachers without taking the prior permission of the Directorate of Education, Delhi.
18. That no demand for the Grant-In-Aid shall be made by the school management for the secondary classes till the Ban on creation of posts/recruitment of posts exists.
19. That a report about the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilled shall be sent to Education Officer every six months.

Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, approval for the upgradation of the existing Sec. school to Sr. Sec. level is granted (without aid) with effect from 1986-87 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act & Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the school shall not appoint any new staff and will continue to operate with the same staff.
4. That the school shall equip the science lab, as per the norms of the department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading-room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student may be added.
6. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of section 10(i) of the Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973.
8. That the enrolment of section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @12 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the classroom and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation, as per the norms of the Dte. of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing classrooms of proper size in the school.

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9. That the school shall not run any un-recognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the above address only. Nursery class be removed from the premises of the school immediately.
10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
11. That the scheme of management shall be got approved from the department immediately.
12. That the service contract between the Management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
13. That all the facilities prescribed under rules 50 & 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
14. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the Local Body within a month.
15. That the management of the school shall create a reserve fund of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand only).
16. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal if recognition of the school.
17. That the nursery classes will not run in the building occupied by the school.
18. That the school shall give complete parity in the pay and allowances of the school employees with effect from 1-4-86.
19. That the report about the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilment shall be sent to Education every 6 month.
